It is estimated that an investment of \$125T will be required to reach net zero by 2050. To fund this transition, major banks, asset managers and institutional investors committed to aligning their lending and investment portfolios to the Paris Agreement climate goals at the Glasgow Financial Alliance for Net Zero launched at the COP26 climate conference in 2021.

As finance moves to the forefront of the fight against climate change, global institutions need to gain more knowledge of the businesses they invest in.

Sustainable finance can play a critical role in decarbonising the steel industry by directing capital towards low-carbon technologies, promoting sustainable practices throughout the industry, and increasing transparency and accountability around environmental performance.

Conference objectives

While the key objective of this event is to share knowledge, it also aims to inspire, connect, and drive meaningful change.

It also offers a unique opportunity for all the stakeholders to gain more insight into sustainable finance topics and solutions, and to get support for the challenges they face.

The conference also aims to shed light on the impact of central banks' investment on global warming and the impact of climate change on corporate governance practices.
